Awash in rich harvest colors, this stunning collection of cards makes liberal use of favorite seasonal imagery. A basket of ripe red apples, a glazed golden pear, and a topaz colored leaf and bauble are all enriched with caramel twill and crocheted trim.

The Fruit of Your Life

Materials

Stampin' Up! Cardstock in Naturals Ivory and Old Olive
BasicGrey Pyrus Collection Double-sided Patterned paper in Cordata, Regul, and Snow Pear
Just Rite Stamp - Autumn Blessings
Paper Fashions, Etc. Stamp Set - Ready for the Harvest
Clearsnap ColorBox Fluid Chalk Ink pad in Chestnut Roan
Tsukineko Memento Ink pad in Tuxedo Black
Copic Markers Ciao Markers
Crocheted trim of choice
Foam dots
Double-sided adhesive
Scissors, ruler, pencil, scoring tool, sponge

Instructions

1 Cut one 5½" x 8½" rectangle from Old Olive cardstock, one 4" x 5¼" rectangle from white side of Snow Pear patterned paper, one 3¾" x 5" rectangle from tree print side of Cordata patterned paper, one 2¼" x 3¾" rectangle from green side of Regul patterned paper, and one 1¼" x 3½" rectangle from Ivory cardstock. Turn Old Olive rectangle horizontally, score a vertical line down the center, and fold in half. Use Chestnut Roan ink pad to antique around outside edges of all cut papers.



2 Working horizontally, use Tuxedo Black ink pad to stamp sentiment ("The fruit your life..." used here) centered onto Ivory rectangle and apple basket image onto Ivory cardstock. Use Ciao Markers to color apple basket image as shown or as desired. Fussy-cut apple basket image, then use Chestnut Roan to antique around outside edges. Adhere top of apple basket image onto bottom left edge of Ivory rectangle as shown, then use foam dots to adhere sentiment rectangle onto top portion and bottom of apple basket image onto bottom portion of Regul rectangle as shown.

3 Cut two 3⅞" lengths from crocheted trim and adhere along back side on top and bottom edge of Regul rectangle. Working vertically, use foam dots to center and adhere assembled Regul rectangle onto Cordata rectangle.

4 Center and adhere Cordata rectangle onto Snow Pear rectangles. With fold on left, center and adhere assembled Cordata rectangle onto card front.



Reap a Harvest

Materials

Stampin' Up! Cardstock in Naturals Ivory and Cranberry Crisp
BasicGrey Pyrus Collection Double-sided Patterned paper in
 Bradford, Regul, and Snow Pear
Paper Fashions, Etc. Stamp Set – Ready for the Harvest
Clearsnap ColorBox Fluid Chalk Ink pad in Chestnut Roan
Memory Makers Paper Reverie Collection Brun Antique Baubles,
 flower
American Crafts 3/8"-wide Twill ribbon in Caramel
 Clear lacquer
 Foam dots
 Double-sided adhesive
 Scissors, ruler, pencil, scoring tool, sponge

Instructions

1 Cut one 5½" x 8½" rectangle from Cranberry Crisp cardstock, one 4" x 5¼" rectangle (large) from print side and one 2½" x 4" rectangle (small) from green side of Regul patterned paper, one 1¾" x 4" rectangle from striped side of Bradford patterned paper, one 1¾" x 3" rectangle from Ivory cardstock, and fussy-cut one pear from print side of Snow Pear patterned paper. Turn the Cranberry Crisp rectangle horizontally, score a vertical line down the center, and fold in half. Use Chestnut Roan ink pad to antique around outside edges of all cut papers.

2 Center and adhere Bradford rectangle with stripes running vertically onto small Regul rectangle with short ends flush. Turn large Regul rectangle horizontally, measure 3/8" in from left edge and vertically adhere assembled Bradford rectangle as shown. Wrap one 17" length of ribbon centered onto Bradford rectangle. Tie ends into a bow, trimming ends evenly.

3 Use Chestnut Roan ink pad to stamp sentiment ("Let us not become weary..." used here) onto Ivory rectangle and to antique around edges, then center and adhere onto green side of Regul patterned paper. Use Chestnut Roan ink pad to antique around outside edges. Measure 3/8" in from right side and 3/4" down from top edge of large Regul rectangle, then use foam dots to adhere sentiment rectangle as shown.

4 Coat fussy-cut pear image with clear lacquer and allow to dry. Use foam dots to adhere pear and flower Bauble onto bottom right side of large Regul rectangle.

5 With fold at top, center and adhere assembled large Regul rectangle onto card front.

Harvest of Thanks



Materials

Stampin' Up! Cardstock in Buckaroo Blue
BasicGrey Pyrus Collection Double-sided collection
Patterned paper in Bradford, Chinese White, Cordata, and Snow Pear
Sentiment stamp – “Thank You”
Clearsnap ColorBox Fluid Chalk Ink pad in Charcoal
K&Company Tim Coffee Fall Harvest 3-D stickers
Memory Makers Paper Reverie Collection Brun
Antique Baubles
American Crafts Twill ribbon in Caramel
Ink pad in black
Small hole punch
Foam dots
Mini glue dots
Double-sided adhesive
Scissors, ruler, pencil, scoring tool, sponge

Instructions

1 Cut one 5½" x 8½" rectangle from Buckaroo Blue cardstock, one 2" x 4" rectangle from tree print side and one 2¼" square from red side of Cordata patterned paper, one 2" x 4" rectangle from black side of Chinese White patterned paper, one 2" x 4" rectangle from striped side of Bradford patterned paper, and two ¼" x 4" strips from both sides of Snow Pear patterned paper. Turn the Buckaroo Blue rectangle horizontally, score a vertical line down the center, and fold in half. Use Charcoal ink pad to antique around outside edges of all cut papers.

2 With fold on left side, horizontally arrange Cordata rectangle, Chinese White rectangle, and Bradford rectangle with stripes running vertically, centered onto card front as shown. When pleased with the

arrangement, adhere in place, then adhere Snow Pear strips to cover paper seams.

3 Center and adhere leaf sticker onto Cordata square. Punch one small hole into bottom right corner of Cordata square. Open the O-ring on Antique Bauble and slip through hole, then close O-ring to secure. Cut one 5" length from Twill ribbon and tie ends into a bow, trimming ends evenly. Adhere bow onto Antique Bauble. Use foam dots to adhere assembled leaf sticker onto top portion of card front, referring to project photo for placement.

4 Use black ink pad to stamp sentiment (“Thank You” used here) onto bottom right side of Bradford rectangle.
