



Bargello Paper Backgrounds
with [Cheery Lynn Designs](#) Weaver and Wicker Dies



Supplies Needed:

[Cheery Lynn Designs Big Wicker die](#)

4 sheets of coordinating card stock

Lightweight white card stock

Black card stock

5 3/8 " square card base

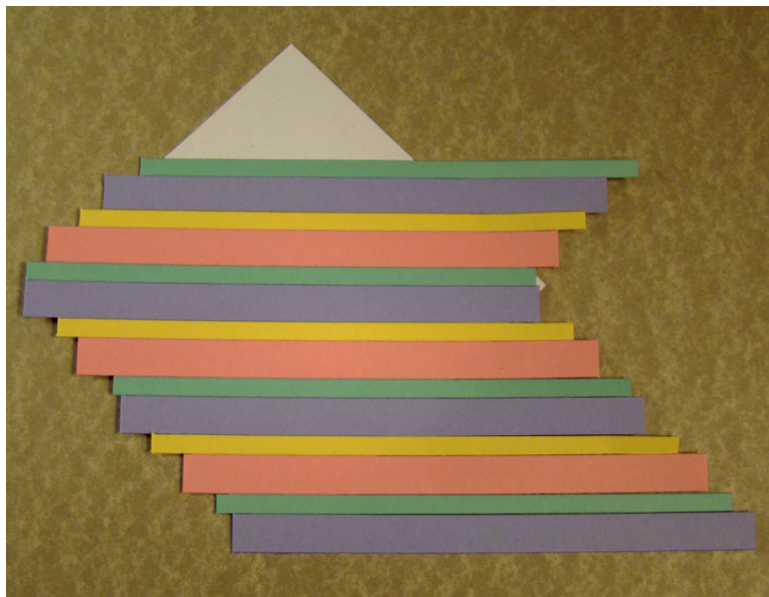




Emboss and die cut 2 panels of 2 colors using the Big Wicker plate and 2 panels of the other 2 colors using the Big Weaver plate.

This will give you many 1/2" strips of 2 colors and 1/4" strips of 2 colors.

Using a 5" square piece of white lightweight card stock as a base, begin gluing down strips of paper on the diagonal in a pattern you like until you fill the base. Create a second panel in the same way. Turn the base over and carefully trim away the excess paper.



This will give you 2 panels that look like this. These can be used as is, or you can cut them on the vertical into strips to create fancy patterns.



The patterns are endless depending on how you cut your strips. This is a great way to use up those solid papers that come in paper collection packs and are a wonderful background for your greeting cards.
