

## Life card

### Materials:

- Marvy® Clear Stamp Markers
- Marvy® Corner punch
- Marvy® Paper Trimming Buddy - with Score blade, Straight Blade, Pinking blade
- Marvy® Dark Brown Ink
- Marvy® Clever Lever Jumbo (Green) - circle
- Marvy® Button Punch
- Marvy® squishy scissors
- Marvy® Mini Glue Tape
- Life and Background Basics: Text Style stamp sets by Papertrey Ink
- Cardstock by Prism Papers
  - Blush Red Medium (cut to 8 ½" x 5 ½" inches)
  - Butter Cream (Cut to 4 ¼" x 5 ½") and a scrap to punch out sentiment.
  - Bronze (for punching buttons)
- Foam Squares by Zva Creative
- Synthetic Sponge by Royal & Langnickle
- burlap string (SM09) by May arts
- Fabri-tac fabric glue by Beacon adhesive
- Acrylic Mounting Handles by Rubber Stamp Concepts



### Instructions:

All measurements are in inches.

1. Score Blush Red Medium cardstock in half (at 4 ¼") to create a card base of 4 ¼" x 5 ½". Trim off part of the front (about 3 inches) with pinking blade. Score lines for decorative element. Round outside corners of back of base. Sponge Edges.
2. Use Markers to color the flower image. Stamp onto Butter Cream layer. Repeat stamping without re-inking to get shadowed effect. Stamp sentiment over the flower. Adhere to the inside of the card base flap. Round corners. Sponge edges.
3. Punch out buttons, Stamp with text image in Dark Brown Ink. Thread with Burlap String then adhere to card with Fabri-tac.
4. Stamp sentiment, punch out. Sponge edges then adhere to card with a few foam squares.
