- * Trace leaves, hands, or other simple shapes and fill them with colorful doodles.
- * Write a name, date or greeting in big outline letters and color around your design.
- * Draw rows of boxes and create colorful comic strips.
- * Draw windows with four or more panes and then fill the panes with what you would see if you looked through them.
- * Draw hearts, polka dots, holiday ornaments, bows, bells, candy canes, hats, animals, stripes, or zig zags.
