

# Class Valentine's Party Layout

*Capture all the fun of the class party in this 12" x 12" layout featuring a handmade banner, stamped cardstock, and graphic-chic patterned paper.*

*Creating and printing a photo collage in a photo editing software program means less time spent cutting and ensures your photos will fit on the page. Some added bling in the form of rhinestone brads are the perfect finishing touch.*

## MATERIALS LIST:

### Paper

64711 Valentine's Pop Collage paper, KFD

64713 Love Bubbles paper, KFD

Bazzill Basics Cardstock

- Classic Red
- Intense Pink
- Frosted Teal

White cardstock

Fine tipped scissors

Die cutting machine and banner die (optional)

Photo editing software (optional)

Small stapler

## INSTRUCTIONS:

1. Trim collage paper by  $\frac{1}{4}$ " on each side and ink edges with Black Soot ink. Adhere to 12" x 12" piece of Intense Pink cardstock.
2. Use photo editing software to print photos to fit in  $8\frac{3}{4}$ " x 5" space. Alternatively, print and crop photos separately. Trim Frosted Teal cardstock to 9" x 9" and stamp with assorted heart images using Breeze ink. Ink edges with Black Soot and adhere to center of layout. Adhere photos as shown, leaving thin blue border along each edge.
3. Print journaling using computer (or handwrite) and trim into strips. Adhere along right side of layout. Embellish with heart sticker, as desired.
4. Mat "Happy Valentine's Day" sticker with Classic Red cardstock and adhere to upper left corner of layout using foam adhesive.
5. Cut five banner flags from Intense Pink cardstock using die cut machine (or trim by hand). Cut five different blank thought bubbles from patterned paper using fine tipped scissors. Adhere to banner flag using glue stick and add alphabet sticker in the center to spell "PARTY". Cut length of ribbon to 14". Adhere left edge to back of layout. Create banner by alternating red and green rhinestone brads between banner flags. Add small staples to ribbon to help the ribbon "bend" to the shape of the banner, hiding the staples behind the banner flags. Continue until the banner is complete and secure other end behind right top edge. Use foam adhesive squares to secure each flag in place, if desired.
