

## Cute as a Button

### Materials

#### Bazzill

- Swiss Dot cardstock in white
- 7/8"-wide Grosgrain ribbon in brown dash

#### BoBunny

- Double Dot cardstock in Brilliant Blue Dot
- Blast Off! Patterned paper in U.F.O.
- Buttons in blue (2), brown (1), and yellow (2)

Pebbles New Arrival cardstock in Perfect Unity Stamps Stamp – Precious Little One

#### Tsukineko

- StazOn Ink pad in Timber Brown
- VersaMagic Chalk Ink pad in Night Sky

#### Judikins Diamond Glaze

EKSUCCESS Edger punch in Double Embossed Dotted Lace

DMC Embroidery floss in brown

Double-sided adhesive

Scissors, ruler, pencil, piercing tool,

embroidery needle, paintbrush



### Instructions

**1** Cut one 6" x 12" rectangle from Perfect cardstock, one 2½ x 3½" rectangle from white Swiss Dot cardstock, and one 5" square from U.F.O. patterned paper. Turn Perfect rectangle horizontally, score a vertical line down the center, and fold in half. Use Timber Brown ink pad to antique around edges of U.F.O. square, then with fold on left, center and adhere onto card front.

**2** Cut one 2¾" x 5" rectangle from Brilliant Blue Dot cardstock, then use Edger punch to punch along both short sides. Use Timber Brown ink pad to antique around edges of white Swiss Dot rectangle, then center and adhere onto

Brilliant Blue Dot rectangle. Use paintbrush and Diamond Glaze to coat each button. Allow to dry. Pierce two holes in each button, then thread embroidery floss through each button hole and tie ends on back. Measure 1½" up from bottom edge and ¼" in from right side and adhere assembled rectangle.

**3** Thread embroidery floss through holes in all buttons and tie ends into a knot on front. Adhere onto card front, referring to project photo for placement.

**4** Cut one 22" length from ribbon. Measure 2" in from fold and wrap ribbon around card front. Tie

ends into a bow on front as shown, trimming ends evenly.

**5** Cut one 1" x 2" rectangle each from white Swiss Dot cardstock and Brilliant Blue Dot cardstock. Use Timber Brown to stamp sentiment ("cute as a button" used here) onto white Swiss Dot rectangle and to antique around outside edges. Use Night Sky to antique around edges of remaining rectangle. Layer rectangles on an angle, then adhere under bow knot as shown in project photo. \*
