Materials

Wausau Paper Cardstock in Umber
Simple Stories Baby Steps Collection

- 6x6 Patterned paper pad in green and white check, multi stripe
- Fundamental Cardstock Stickers
- 4x4 Quotes and 6x8 Mat Elements

Spellbinders

Corner rounder

Clearsnap Chalk Ink pad in Creamy Brown

DMC Embroidery floss in dark brown

Elmer's

- Dot Runner Adhesive
- Foam tape

Scissors, ruler, pencil, paper piercer, embroidery needle



Instructions

1 Cut one 5" x 10" rectangle from Umber cardstock, one 4½" square from green and white check patterned paper, one 3½" square from small grid patterned paper, and one 1½" x 4½" strip from stripe patterned paper (with stripes running vertically). Turn Umber rectangle horizontally, score a vertical line down the center, and fold in half. Adhere stripe strip along bottom edge of green and white check square, then round corners as shown. With fold at top,

center and adhere onto card front. Round corners on bottom edge of card front.

2 Use large Lacey Square die to cut one square from Umber cardstock. Use foam tape to center and adhere onto card front.

3 Use black ink pad to stamp hot air balloon image and sentiment ("Heaven Sent" used here) onto small grid patterned paper, referring to project photo for placement. Use

Marker to color image as shown or as desired, then use Creamy Brown ink pad to antique around edges. Use paper piercer to create evenly spaced holes around inside edge, then use floss to create a row of backstitches as shown. Arrange buttons and jewel stickers around hot air balloon image as shown. When pleased with the arrangement, adhere. Center and adhere completed square onto Lacey Square.
